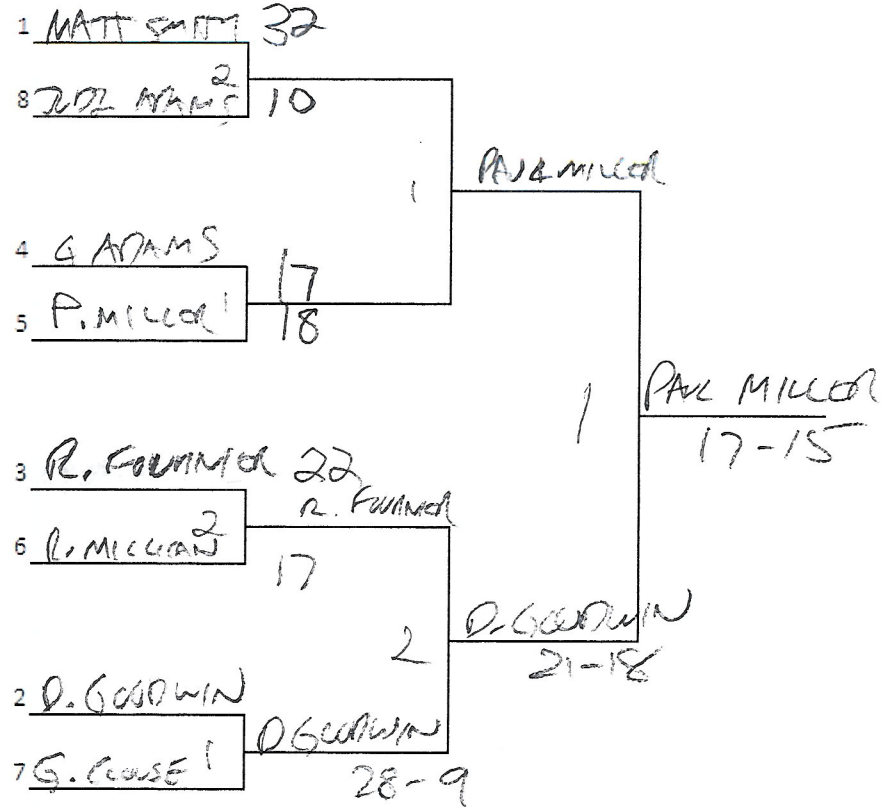

Troy White of Rockville, Missouri, passed away April 23, 2013. He was 49 years old. Troy lived in Rockville, Missouri most of his life. During his life, he worked for JLS Coal Company and also Wilson Plumbing. Troy loved the small town life and especially enjoyed being outdoors. Troy started playing nine-wicket cutthroat croquet in the early 1980's and started playing in tournaments around this same time.

Around 2009, Troy joined the USCA and played in the annual Nine-Wicket USCA National Championship tournament held in Kansas City. Welcome to the 2013 Lee's Summit T-Bone Tournament. We are running two divisions from the start today - a Pro Division and a Gold Division.

The Pro Division has eight players and will be a random draw for three rounds based on matching players to the win level. To help avoid repeat matchups, round one was randomly drawn as hi vs low based on subjective rankings. Random.org was used to generate the random numbers to set the first round matchups. A die will be used to set the matchups for rounds two and three on site. All players will advance to the playoff and will be seeded according to record. Tie-breaker is head-to-head, gross points, net points, stake lag.

The Gold Division will operate as a standard five-player block with all players playing all players. The top two players in the standings advance to a championship game. There will be a consolation third place game if the participants want to play. Tie-breaker is the same as the Pro Division.
